Supports the proposal by the New Zealand Government, in accordance with international best practice, to require mandatory, publicly-available climate change risk disclosure by publicly-listed companies, banks, general insurers, asset owners and asset managers, finance firms, and large non-listed companies.”

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Mandatory risk disclosure creates awareness of the climate crisis and facilitates mitigation and adaptation.
