PROTECTING PERSONAL INFORMATION



- Purpose: have a clear need for collecting and using personal information.
- Accuracy: Personal information should be accurate and up-to-date. Fix any mistakes promptly.
- Data minimisation: Collect only what you need; keep only what you need.
- Lifecycle: Make smart choices about information while it is in your care. Dispose of information safely.
- Openness: Be open about how you use personal information.
- Control: Protect data at all times.
- Knowledge: Tell people why information is being collected and how it is being used.
