
Rātapu Nīkau/Palm Sunday: There is another way.

Hosanna! Blessed is one who comes in name of the Lord. —Mark 11:9

Jesus, riding into Jerusalem was an exciting community event, showing a different way to lead that does not involve violence. Jesus rode a donkey- a symbol of peace, rather than riding a horse- a symbol of war. Often having an impairment means having to do things in a different way. For example: someone who is Deaf may communicate in sign language or by written word or in visual images, someone who is neurodiverse may need quiet space to process thoughts and feelings.
