We use the *Complete Anglican Hymns Old and New*. The position, which is voluntary, is available due to the retirement at the end of the year of our organist of many years.

**Key Responsibilities:**

- Accompany the main Sunday Service (9 am). Ideally this would be three Sundays a month. Each service has four hymns, and a voluntary.
- Provide musical accompaniment for other services throughout the church year, including special liturgical occasions.

- Proven competence and experience in liturgical settings.
- A deep understanding and sympathy for the Anglican tradition of worship.
- Commitment to creating a spiritually enriching worship experience through music.
